The Digital North East Vision 2022 consists of eight digital thrust areas mainly focusing on enhancing connectivity, telecom infrastructure, digital infrastructure, digitisation, proliferation of various digital services, digital empowerment of citizens, promotion of electronic manufacturing, promotion of IT and IT-enabled Services including BPOs, cyber security and a special thrust on innovation & startups. This will bring in synergy for digital transformation leading to exponential yet inclusive and sustainable growth in the lives of the people of the region.

STPI has been actively engaged and effectively contributing in creating an ecosystem for fostering innovation and startups in the region by promoting IT/ITeS industry through Single Window Clearance to Software Exporting Units. As part of its pan-India operations, STPI is promoting the export of IT software and services in the NE region by offering incentives via STP/EHTP schemes as well as Infrastructure support by means of Data Communications and Incubation facilities to micro, small and medium entrepreneurs and actively working as an interface between the Government and the Industry partners.

Under Digital North East Vision 2022, STPI shall be setting up domain specific Centres of Excellence (CoEs) in capital city of incubation spaces at each CoE shall also have domain specific labs, tools, services and pool of mentors along with single-window facilitation for technical mentorship, business mentoring, networking, market access, funding, IPR/Patenting and IP protection, etc. SIZs shall engage students and professionals to further develop tinkering and innovation culture. To boost entrepreneurship further, STPI, in partnership with Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDoNER), shall conduct IT/ITeS Hackathons/Challenges and generate excitement among youth and encourage them to contribute towards the Vision.

To promote the BPO industry and to create ample job opportunities in the far flung areas of NE, 5,000 seats were allocated under NEBPS. Entrepreneurs and Industry have leveraged the advantage of English speaking youth of the region along with benefits of the scheme and created job opportunities in the neighborhood.

The importance of 'Digital North East Vision 2022' cannot be over-emphasised. Integrating North East has always been critical to the digitisation of socio-economic sphere of the country. Integrating eight North Eastern states to India's 'Trillion dollar digital opportunity' is a welcome move. STPI has been striving hard to achieve the mandate of the Government in collaboration with State Governments of North East and Industry. □

Vision for Digital North East Launched

Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Hon'ble Minister of Electronics & Information Technology, Govt. of India released the vision document for the Digital North East 2022 at Guwahati on 11th August 2018. Chief Ministers of North Eastern states, senior government officials, technocrats and industry leaders were present at the event.

The Digital North East Vision 2022 was released with the objective to improve IT sector of the region. It shall boost the efforts for building a Digital North East.

The vision document has developed state-wise roadmaps for implementing digital initiatives in North Eastern states. Through these, it aims to empower the people of the North Eastern states. Under Digital North East programme, Union Government will invest nearly Rs. 10,000 crore in the region over the



next four years to implement more than 400 projects.

Eight thrust areas are identified namely, digital infrastructure, digital services, digital empowerment, promotion of electronics manufacturing, promotion of IT & ITeS including BPOs, digital payments, innovation & startup and cyber security towards building a Digital North East.

BPO Industry Needs Recalibration

On the sidelines of release of Digital North East Vision 2022, STPI organised a networking workshop in Guwahati. Leaders of BPO industry from the North East & various other regions of the country participated in the workshop. They shared their views on mentoring the NEBPS units to help grow the BPO industry by adopting the "Hub and Spoke" model.

Shri Rajiv Kumar, Joint Secretary, MeitY, Govt. of India delivered the keynote address elaborating the objectives of the workshop and BPO promotion initiatives of MeitY under the Digital India programme of Government of India. Shri Kumar emphasised the need for creation of an ecosystem for the growth of BPO activities in smaller towns and bringing prosperity to these locations.

He touched upon various challenges the BPO units are facing in the North Eastern region, in achieving desired growth and becoming sustainable. He also expressed the need of focusing on emerging technology areas towards which the BPO industry is moving.

Dr. Omkar Rai, DG, STPI emphasised on the benefits of IBPS and NEBPS which are helping to generate employment in Tier-II and Tier-III cities. He stated that with increased focus of the Government on e-governance and impetus of the industry towards better customer services, the need for BPO will continuously increase and the NEBPS units should take advantage of this with the help of state governments.



He further added that the BPO industry needs recalibration due to digital transformation, automation, emerging technology, adoption of cloud tools and social media.

Shri Raman Roy, CMD, Quatrro Global Services cited some of his experiences about the challenges faced by BPO industry. He advised BPO units to look beyond telecom sectors to make their business profitable and further added that scale-up in size up to a minimum 600 to 700 seats is essential for a BPO unit to become sustainable, as the outsourced work is required to be disintegrated into smaller components and the service provider should have the capability to create groups within the organisation to handle different components.

Shri Nayanjyoti Bhattacharyya, MD, Anjaybee InfoTech Pvt. Ltd., Guwahati spoke about his journey in the BPO industry in the North East and mentioned that the talent pool in the North East is undoubtedly very good. Climbing up the value chain would, therefore, be possible, provided the leaders in BPO industry give them business opportunities. He reiterated that workshop like this needs to be frequently organised to help local BPO units develop relationship with the BPO leadership.

Shri Ayaskanta Mohanty, MD, Tatwa Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar was proud to state that he has already started working in hub and spoke model by setting up smaller BPO unit in Guwahati, which is working in sync with BPO units in Bhubaneswar and other places. He emphasised on the need of giving preferential treatment to NEBPS units for government works.

Shri Kalyan Kar, EX-MD, Acclaris, Director & Co-Founder InQube Innoventures Pvt. Ltd. showed great optimism in looking forward to a rapid growth of BPO industry in the North East region with the active support of stakeholders.

On 23rd July 2018, Dr. Edward Rogers, Chief Knowledge Officer, Goddard Space Flight Center, NASA and visiting faculty, ISB Mohali addressed entrepreneurs and other eminent personalities from the IT industry as a speaker of the "Knowledge Speaker Series" at STPI Incubation Centre, Mohali. Starting with the viability of the idea of making beer in space, he took the audience on a journey of generating ideas or in his words, "finding space between two things." He talked about recombination of products to make revolutionary changes, how SpaceX succeeded in making reusable rockets (something which was deemed impossible), and how perception changes the whole game.

He introduced the concept of finding gaps and relations between things, a concept different from the linear thought process of human beings. Using vivid examples, he held an interesting session. The audience, charmed by his presentation, was lost in thoughts.
